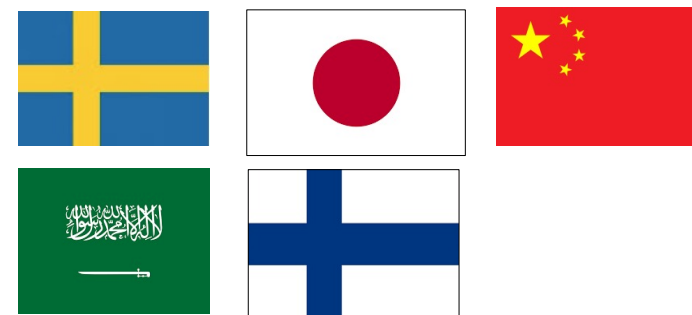

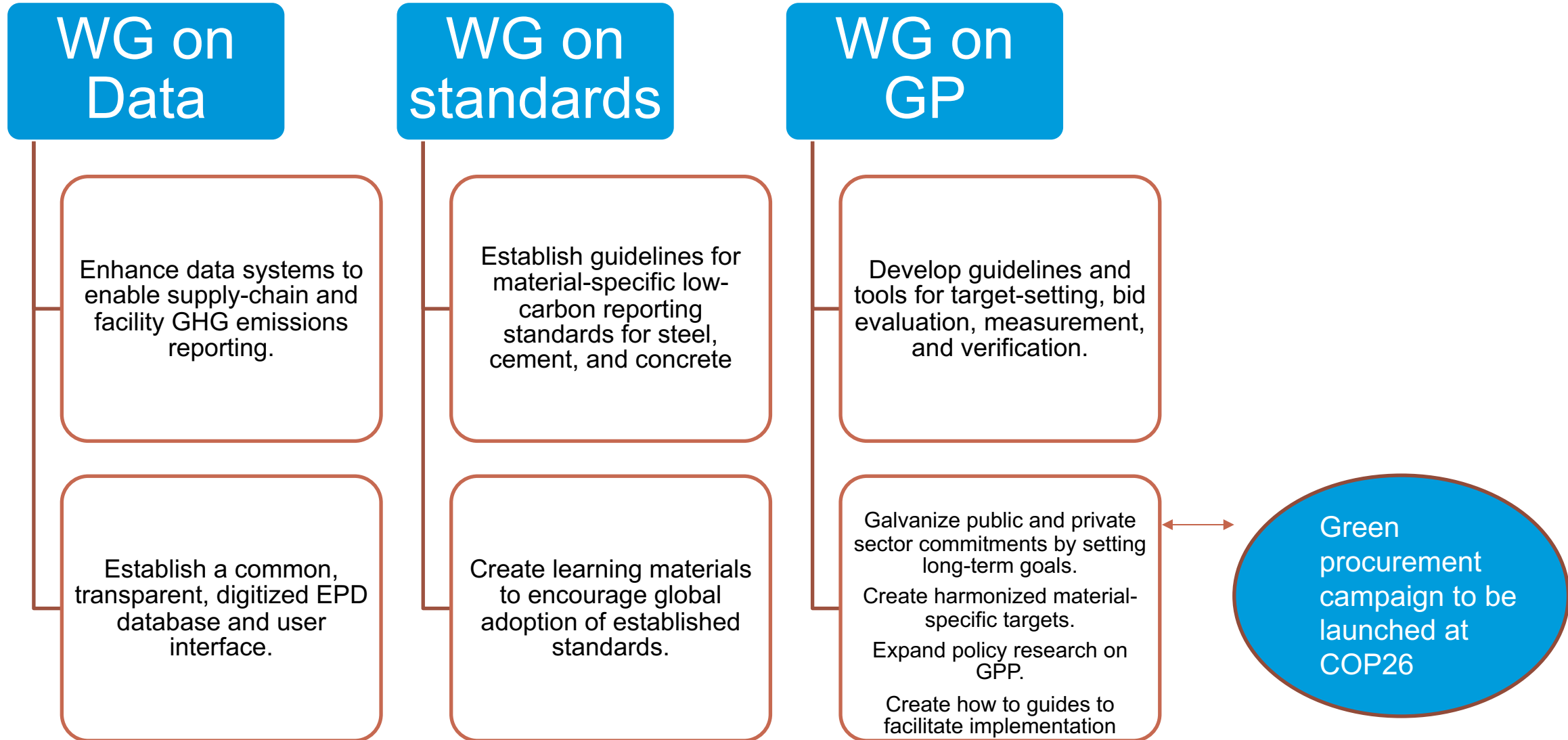


Initiative Objective
