### NDE Germany matchmaking workshop in Brazil

The NDE Germany together with the NDE Brazil invites interested companies, experts and organizations to their matchmaking workshop on e-mobility from July 03-05, 2017 in Sao Paulo, Brazil. The workshop aims at presenting technology solutions for accelerating the transfer of climate friendly e-mobility solutions. Companies, relevant stakeholders and organisations will present their innovative solutions at the workshop and discusss with potential partners on future cooperation possibilities between Germany and Brazil. During the two day workshop the focus will **be on electric vehicles (passenger cars and buses), charge points and batteries.** 

As the UNFCCC focal point for Germany, the NDE Germany, under the direction of the Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Energy supports the accelerated transfer of climate technology. The NDE Germany thereby supports Brazil in reaching ambitious climate targets through active engagement and cooperation.

#### Program

The workshop taking place on July 03-05, 2017 is organized together with the NDE Brazil, as part of the Ministry for Science, Technology and Innovation (MCTIC), ABINEE, ABVE and CNI. In addition to the German participants, key speakers, technology experts and organisations, Brazilian stakeholders will present on their experiences with e-mobility and the possibility for future cooperation. Experts will present, discuss in panels and during several technology briefings and discussion groups on the various aspects of implementing e-mobility technologies at a large scale in Brazil. The workshop provides ample opportunities for networking and open discussions with relevant stakeholders and participants of the workshop as such.
